



Corona protocol - VISITORS

In this document you will find the health and safety measures we have taken according to the Dutch legislation to visit the Vakbeurs Foodspecialiteiten. It is evident and most important to us that you, as a visitor, also adhere to all these measures. Together we make sure the exhibition will be a safe place for all of us.

The exhibition is organised according to the guidelines of the RIVM, but also in such a way that good conversations and conviviality are possible on the exhibition floor. Below is an overview of the measures we had to take.

These measures are based on and depend on government decisions. We will confirm to these rules and regulations at all times.

- **Social distancing** - Keep at least 1.5 meters from others than your own party
- **Health check** - A week before the exhibition you will receive an e-mail with a link to a health check. Please complete this before visiting. A health check will also be done at the entrance.
- **Disinfection stations** - You will find disinfection stations at the entrance and in several places in the exhibition building to disinfect your hands.
- **Hygiene measures**
 - Wash your hands regularly
 - Cough and sneeze on the inside of your elbow
 - Use paper tissues and throw them away immediately
 - Do not shake hands
 - Leave coats etc. (without valuables) in the car where possible
- **Register** - Registration upfront for access is mandatory. When registering, you can choose a time when the exhibition will be visited, in order to avoid queues at the entrance. After arrival you can stay as long as desired. A maximum of 1600 people may be present on the exhibition floor at the same time. The numbers are registered and monitored closely by means of check-in and check-out. If the limit is reached, new visitors will be asked to wait outside.
- **Stay at home** - Stay at home with mild cold symptoms such as sniffing, coughing, sore throat or fever, unless there is a negative test evidence.
- **Social distancing stewards** - Our colleagues are ready to provide assistance on the exhibition floor if necessary.
- **Extra cleaning** - Contact surfaces are cleaned on a regular basis.
- **Walking routes and guidelines** - In accordance with the RIVM measures applicable at that time.
- **Expo Houten** - The ventilation facility and capacity are in accordance with the guidelines set out here. Expo Houten has outdoor air ventilation in all exhibition halls.
- **Catering** - All sandwiches, sweet treats etc. are individually packed or sold. Sustainable disposables are used as much as possible. Drinks will be served in PET bottles/packages as much as possible.
- **Aftercare** - We request that visitors notify us if they experience complaints after their visit. Of course this is not mandatory, but it can prevent the spread of the virus.

The organisation reserves the right to exclude visitors with Corona symptoms complaints, fever and/or those who do not comply with the safety and precautionary measures from further visit.
